It is the responsibility of the sending facility to determine the appropriate level of provider to staff the transfer "based on the patient's current and anticipated condition and needs" (stability and risk of deterioration). Higher acuity patients may require additional staffing.

No 2nd License – means an inter-facility transfer request was sent out via mass messaging and only one response was received from a single licensed provider.

No Crew – means an inter-facility transfer request was sent out via mass messaging and no response was received.
